SBA PROGRAMS

The Missouri SBDC offers the following SBA programs in communities throughout the state.



SBDC centers work with regional and district SBA offices and the USDA to provide Rural Strong events in their regions. These events help to engage business owners in the many rural communities around the state and provide education on the services available to strengthen businesses.

SBDC centers across the state partner with the regional or district SBA office to provide the Boots to Business and/or Boots to Business Reboot programs to active duty military, Veterans, and their spouses.





Urban SBDCs offer the Emerging Leaders program to develop business owners through classroom training, homework, and peer-to-peer mentoring.

ScaleUP! Kansas City, originally funded by the SBA for two years, is still going strong. Now starting their ninth cohort, business owners from around the KC metro area are scaling and seeing success from this program.
